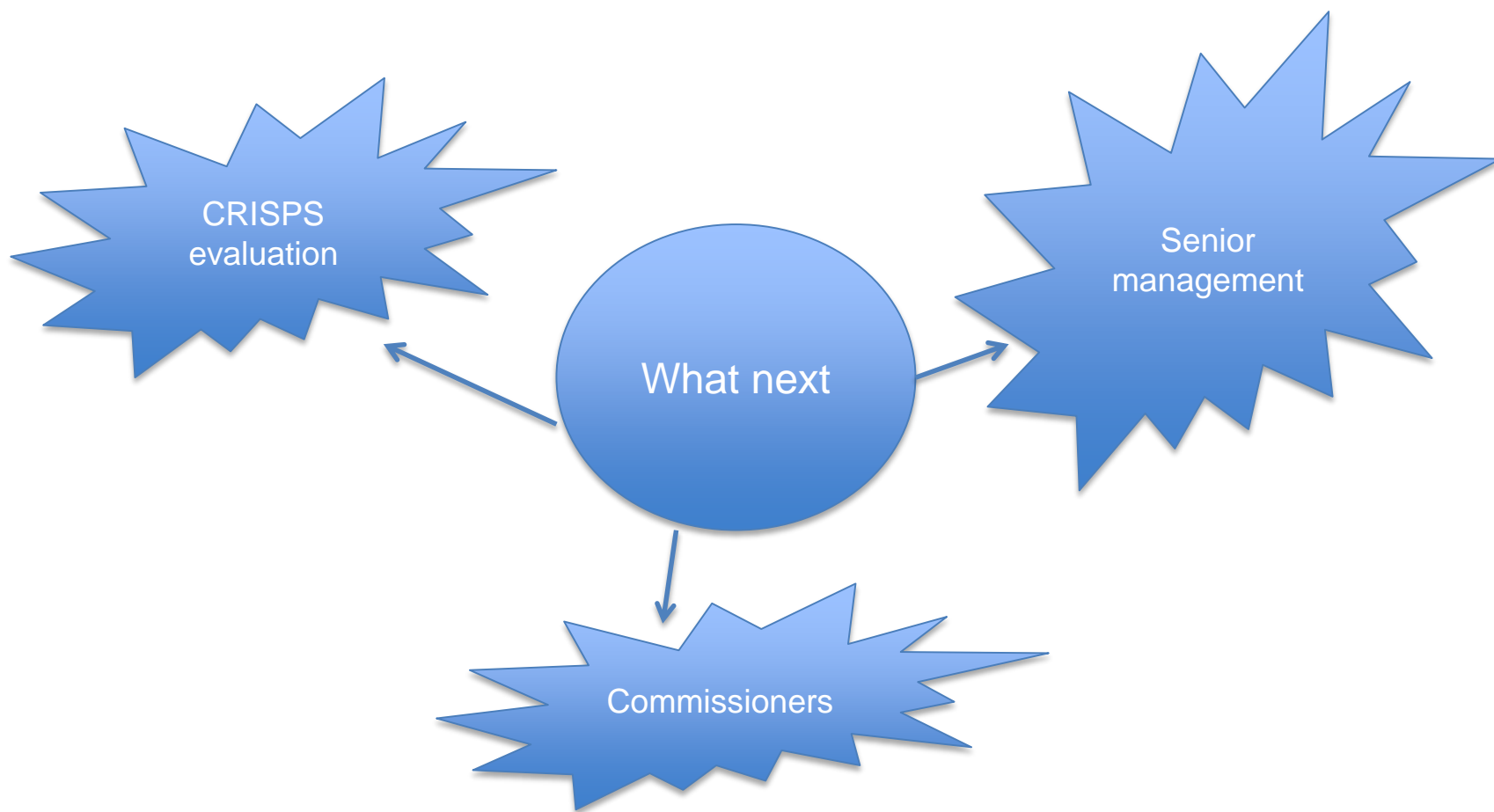

CRISPS Evaluation

- CRISPS (carers require information to support personality disorder)
- Carers attended two awareness sessions .
- From the evaluations received there was a clear identified need for more intensive support/training for carers.
- It was also identified that it was more meaningful if somebody with a lived experience delivered the training.

Senior management

- The feedback from the evaluations led to us developing a training education support programme (TES).
- This is a skills based approach to working with carers/family.
- A business case for a peer support worker to deliver the programme was presented to senior management.

Commissioners

- We attended a number of meetings with our commissioners, with our business proposal who were extremely receptive.
- A pilot study CQUIN (Commissioning for Quality & Innovation) was established for twelve months and from the successful outcome of the audit undertaken, it has now been commissioned across all the five boroughs.

Employment

- This has led to a full time position as a Highly Specialist Peer Support Worker.
- The vision is that carers who have completed the programme will then progress to be trained to deliver the programme employing more Peer support workers.
- The future direction is to now adapt the programme across the other business streams within the organisation.

Next Steps

- Provide workshops to carers/family members of the basic principles & components of psychological therapies;
- DBT dialectical behaviour therapy.
- MBT mentalisation based therapy.
- SCM structured clinical management.
